The Geospatial Education Platform (GEP) is now available

Colleagues of the Department of Land Surveying and Geo-Informatics, Department of Computing, and the Education Development Centre of PolyU, The Chinese University of Hong Kong, and The University of Hong Kong have completed a teaching and learning project jointly funded by the University Grants Council and the Hong Kong Polytechnic University. The objectives of the project entitled the Geospatial Education Forum (GEF) were, amongst others, to develop the framework for a New Geospatial Education Curriculum (the NGC); establish a set of core challenges the NGC will present to geospatial educators; develop and test a set of solutions to these challenges.

In order to disseminate the outputs of the GEF as widely as possible, an online platform, the Geospatial Education Platform (GEP) has been established.
