

Secondary School Students Visited LSGI



In order to learn more about the undergraduate programmes in Geomatics, two groups of F.4 and F.5 students from Wa Ying College and St Louis School visited Department of Land Surveying and Geo-Informatics (LSGI) on 30 October and 12 November respectively.

During the visit, students learned about the subjects and the programmes on offer, admission requirements and career prospects. LSGI student representatives shared their study experiences in LSGI and university life. Students had the opportunity to learn the GNSS instruments and satellite facility demonstrated by our research students.
