This presentation will talk about the development and implementation of the Chinese lunar Exploration program including technical achievements, scientific results, and the prospect of Chinese lunar missions. The Chinese 2020 Mars exploration missions will also be introduced.

### **Biography**

Prof. Li Fei received his BSc from the University of Science and Technology of China in 1982 and PhD from the Institute of Geodesy and Geophysics, Chinese Academy of Sciences in 1992. He is currently the Vice-President of Wuhan University and the Director of the Chinese Antarctic Research Center of Surveying and Mapping (CACSM) of Wuhan University. He also serves as Vice-Chairman of advisory committee for geophysics of ministry of education, the member of Chinese Lunar Exploration Science Applications Committee of Experts, and the Chinese Society of Oceanography.

Prof. Li has broad research interests that include Gravity, geophysical inversion and Geodesy, and mainly focuses on the research of polar geophysics and geodesy, lunar gravity field and internal structure. He has undertaken and completed more than 30 research projects and published more than journal 150 papers.
