He has been enrolled in Beijing Nova Program of Science and Technology (2011), obtained National Youth Geographical Science and Technology Award. Currently his work is mainly about geographical spatial cognition theory. Dr. Dong has so far published more than 30 papers in peer-reviewed journals as first or corresponding author and 3 monographs. He also takes responsibility or takes part in more than 10 National Key Basic Research Program of China (973 Program), National High Technology Research and Development Program of China (863 Program), or National Natural Science Foundation of China.
